Matthew Angelo Harrison wins LACMA's Art + Technology Lab grant

Matthew Angelo Harrison has been awarded LACMA's Art + Technology Lab grant, a \$45,000 award for an art project that engages with emerging technologies. One of four artists chosen from 600 submissions, Harrison will collaborate with scientists on creating a material that can be used for 3D printing of structural environments relevant to his ongoing exploration of "Abstract Ancestry." Harrison's project is titled "The Consequence of Platforms."

The Los Angeles County Museum's Art + Technology Lab receives the support of an advisory board composed of the leading innovators across a variety of tech industries including: Accenture, Hyundai, Snap Inc., SpaceX and YouTube Learning.

In 2021, Harrison will enjoy solo exhibitions at the Kunsthalle Basel, Switzerland, and then at the MIT List Visual Arts Center, Cambridge, MA. His work is currently on view in Jessica Silverman's summer show, "Conversational Spirits." Harrison lives and works in Detroit.
