

Jessica Silverman Announces Details for Frieze Los Angeles 2026 at Booth A16

SAN FRANCISCO, CA (February 3, 2026) – Jessica Silverman is pleased to participate in **Frieze Los Angeles's** 2026 edition, running from February 26 to March 1, 2026 at the Santa Monica Airport.

For the fifth consecutive year at the fair, Jessica Silverman will host a group exhibition of new and historic works. The presentation will be located at **booth A16** in a new, centralized location in the fair's main tent.

Highlights will include a focused presentation of new bas-relief paintings by **Beverly Fishman**. Her brightly-colored and highly-polished geometric works are built from a unique

visual language that engages biotechnology. These sophisticated compositions are in dialogue with wellness culture, altered states of being, and medical treatment.

An additional highlight will include significant, never-before-seen drawings from Judy Chicago's "Color Fragments" series. Created in 1968, these works deploy self-devised schematics to probe the optical and emotional power of color and light, foregrounding a minimalist visual language anchored in feminist questions of perception and selfhood.
